INSTRUCTOR: 1 • LENGTH: 45, 60 OR 90 MINUTES COST: \$135/45 MINUTES, \$150/60 MINUTES, \$225/90 MINUTES

The design of the drumming program scaffolds learning, creating both a horizontal and vertical alignment of knowledge and skills. With each advancement in grade or course level, increases in student achievement will be demonstrated by the degree, scope and depth of knowledge and skills learned. Students will begin their music education at an awareness level and move through grade sequences building their understandings of the tools of the discipline, i.e., vocabulary, elements, concepts, and principles. They will study the circumstances and events that influenced composers and musicians in order to preserve certain musical styles and traditions. Lastly, students will learn to confidently and credibly compare, contrast, synthesize, and evaluate personal works and the works of others.

#### DANCE

African, Ballet, Jazz, Hip Hop and Modern

In addition they will develop coordination, confidence, body awareness and build self-esteem as they learn the fundamentals of dance including; basic body isolations, precision, performance quality, and choreography.

The focus of this class is perception, creative expression/performance and historical/cultural heritage. Students will learn to read a script and are cast in multiple acting roles. Their progression, including their performance techniques and knowledge of the history taught is assessed on a weekly basis. Mandatory rehearsals are scheduled two hours a week for a total 60 sessions throughout the duration of the class.

#### VISUAL ARTS

INSTRUCTOR: 1 • LENGTH: 60 MINUTES • COST: \$150

Workshops in visual arts are teach students how to create collages, murals, and photography. These workshops are developed to teach students how to tell stories through the past, present, and future.
